Bassam Al-Kuwatli is a Syrian activist based in Gaziantep, southern Turkey. He heads an organisation called RMTeam that provides a variety of services to donors, local and international NGOs and private institutions. He has been involved in political activism since 1991, taking a principled stand against the concept and system of inheriting the presidency. Al-Kuwatli has been supportive of the Syrian uprising since the beginning and has managed the peace-building, justice and police department within the Assistance Coordination Unit of the National Coalition of Syrian Revolution and Opposition Forces (Etilaf), set up to coordinate assistance to all those affected by the crisis, from March-September 2013. Prior to that, he was a founding member of the Syrian National Bloc in May 2011 and a member of the Syrian National Council in November 2011. He holds an advanced degree in Computer Science and an MA in Conflict Analysis and Management.
